To ensure a cooperative, safe, and caring environment, the following contract will be enforced by the staff of the North Berwick Summer Camp.

Camp Rules:

1. Directions are followed the first time they are given.
2. We keep our hands, feet, mouths and objects to ourselves.
3. We stay with our assigned group and in our assigned area.
4. We make proper use of all of the facilities including the restrooms.
5. We use materials, supplies, and indoor and outdoor equip. properly.
6. We **always** treat others with respect and never use foul language.
7. We never call others names, tease or bully others.
8. We will not hit, kick, bite, scratch, or choke others.
9. We will not steal, destroy, or touch other people's property.
10. We will not come into the Community Center without a counselor.
11. We will not be disrespectful by making faces, talking back, being mouthy, etc.
12. We will dress appropriately and modestly.
13. NO expensive items like ipods, mp3 players, gameboys, PSP's, etc at camp.
14. **NO** Cell phones at camp unless prior arrangements have been made.

We hope that by having this contract and these rules that our camp will be a safer place for all. We understand that the behavior of one camper can have a significant impact on the group, so we are committed to ensuring that our campers show respect for one another, property, and for our staff.
