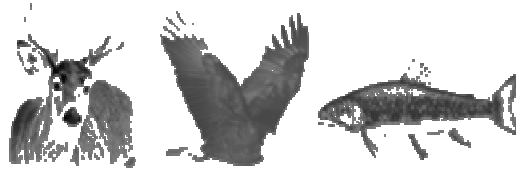

Hunting and Fishing Licenses

The Town Clerk's office is a certified sales agent with the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. We are authorized to sell Resident and Non-resident Hunting and Fishing Licenses.

Residency Requirements

Individuals may claim only one state or province as their legal residence.

You are considered a Maine resident if:

- a) You are registered to vote in Maine or
- b) You are licensed to drive a motor vehicle, made application for a Maine motor vehicle license or
- c) You own a motor vehicle or vehicles located within the State, registered each such vehicle in Maine or
- d) You have complied with State income tax laws or
- e) If you are a full-time student at a Maine college or university, and satisfy the above requirements.

Nonresident means a citizen of the United States who does not fall within the definition of Alien or Resident.

Alien means a person who is not a citizen of the United States.

Anyone purchasing a hunting license is required to show either proof of a previous hunting license or proof of hunter safety course participation.

Licenses may be purchased in the Town Office during regular hours.
