Section 5. Consumer Fireworks Display Permit

5. A consumer Fireworks Display Permit will not be issued on a Class 4 or Higher Fire Danger Day as determined by the Maine Forest Service.

Section 6. Violations

Any person who uses consumer and /or commercial fireworks or possesses such fireworks with the intent to use in the Town of North Berwick in violation of the ordinance shall receive a civil citation. Any person who violates this ordinance shall to a fine of \$500.00, plus court cost, for each offense.

Selectman MacDougall commented that the \$500.00 fine was high.

Selectman Danforth suggested a graduating fine scale: 1<sup>st</sup> offense \$50.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> offense \$100.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> offense \$250.00 and 4<sup>th</sup> offense \$500.00.

The Town Manager and the Board of Selectmen continued discussion on the Fireworks Ordinance.

### **C. Parks and Rec:** Update on Event Process

Dwayne explained that approximately one hundred and fifty participants attended the Halloween Howler event despite the blizzard.
