

Fire Works Ordinance/Permits

Chief Gosselin would like to remind the citizens of No. Berwick that you must have a permit to display consumer fireworks. You must be 21 years of age or older to obtain a permit. Hours of use are 9:00am to 10:00pm except on July 4th and December 31st when they may be used from 9:00am to 12:30 am the following day. They must not be used within 50 ft. of combustible materials. They may only be used when Fire danger conditions, as determined by the Maine Forest Service, are Low, Moderate or High. Permits may be obtained free of charge at the fire station on Market Street Saturday and Sunday mornings from 9am-10am or at the Town Office during regular business hours.

North Berwick Emergency Management Agency

wants to keep you informed in the event of an emergency that affects our community, and in order to do so we need everyone to register for the York County RAVE Alert Emergency Notification System through Smart 911.

The RAVE Alert Emergency Notification System is primarily activated for weather related emergencies to include major storms that could cause extreme flooding and property damage. The system may also be used to notify residents of other emergencies that require immediate attention or action by residents.

This system is used to provide urgent information which may include specific information and/or instructions.

This system is not used for traffic and school delays, cancellations of any kind or parking bans.

Open Burning

A reminder that in the State of Maine, Burning Permits are required Year-Round (even with snow on the ground). Open Burning Permits are issued on Low and Moderate fire danger days from 9am to midnight and on High fire danger days, from 5pm to Midnight. No permits are issued on Very High or Extreme fire danger days.

2. You may also obtain a permit free of charge at the fire station on Market Street Saturday and Sunday mornings from 9am-10am or at the Town Office during regular business hours.

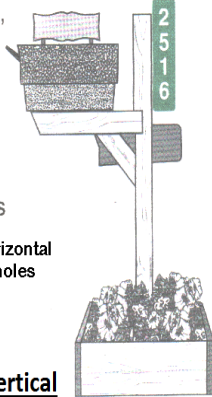
